This position works out of Boulder, Colorado. This is a full-time, hourly position with benefits, and reports to the Program Director.

The mission of the "I Have A Dream" program is to empower children from under-resourced communities (Dreamer Scholars) to succeed in school, college, and career by providing academic, social, and emotional support from elementary school through college, along with post-secondary tuition assistance.

Responsibilities:

- Demonstrates open, clear and timely communication skills when dealing with Americorps, volunteers, students, families and school personnel
- Team Leads volunteers and informs and delegates any management issues to their Program Director
- Communicates program goals and outcomes, role definitions and coaches the Volunteers to be in line with I Have A Dream Foundation values
- In tune with team, students and families emotional state and is self aware enough to be able to manage emotional responses in a professional setting
- Has enough self regulation to manage their emotions to help them work with their teams and seeks counsel when appropriate
- Being able to navigate a variety of emotional states to support program quality
- Tracks attendance and academic achievement and provides data to their Program Director to help meet student outcomes
- Continuous positive outreach to dreamer scholar students, builds connections to become a trusted adult for their youth, and provides social and emotional support
- Ability to drive a company vehicles in a safe way
